

RESOLUTION #2018-1

RESOLUTION OF THE LITTLE EGG HARBOR MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY REGARDING THE NEEDED REPAIR OF THE SANITARY SEWER LINE AT 7 ATLANTIS BOULEVARD

WHEREAS, the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as "Authority") has been advised by its Consulting Engineer, Remington & Vernick Engineers, of a sanitary sewer line collapse at 7 Atlantis Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has been advised by its Consulting Engineer by letter dated January 9, 2018 that the gravity sewer line collapsed and is totally blocked, and the Authority finds that an emergency must be declared in order to authorize the immediate expenditure of funds to repair the line; and

WHEREAS, the Authority previously awarded a contract to Mathis Construction Company Inc. for emergency water and sewer repair services after public advertisement and the receipt of formal bids in accordance with the provisions of the "Local Public Contracts Law", N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 9th day of January 2018 by the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1 - The Authority accepts the recommendation of its Consulting Engineer and declares an emergency regarding the repair of the sanitary sewer line in order to immediately repair the sanitary sewer line to avoid the potential adverse effects to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents.
- 2 - The Authority authorizes its Executive Director to undertake the necessary work with Mathis Construction Company Inc. in accordance with the unit prices for labor and materials previously adopted by the Authority.
- 3 - The Authority authorizes and directs its Chairman, Secretary, and/or Executive Director to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.

Per your request, we have investigated the sewage blockage at 7 Atlantis Boulevard.

It appears that the gravity sewer has collapsed and that the line is totally blocked. We recommend that the Authority declare an emergency to have the line repaired

Under the publicly bid annual contract for Emergency Repairs awarded to Mathis Construction Co. for this year, there are unit prices for all labor and materials, which will be used. This emergency declaration is due to the potential adverse effects to the health, safety and welfare of the Township residents. Any considerations necessary to temporarily restore travel lanes to residents is essential.
