R.S. 52:27BB-52: A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.

Our office is in receipt of a letter from your office dated June 14, 2022 requesting a formal 30-day contract time extension for the Decommissioning of Well No.5 for the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority.

The time-extension request is due to the unforeseen circumstance of the well being obstructed by debris upon the removal of the six-inch inner casing. As the conditions encountered will require an alternate plan of abandonment to be submitted to the NJDEP for approval, the NJDEP has approved an extension of the compliance period for the decommissioning of Well No.5.
