# RESOLUTION OF THE LITTLE EGG HARBOR MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY REGARDING THE NEEDED REPAIR OF A SEWER COLLAPSE AT TWO LOCATIONS ON SOUTH LONGBOAT DRIVE

WHEREAS, the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as "Authority") has been advised by its Consulting Engineer, Remington & Vernick Engineers, of repairs required for a sewer collapse on October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024 in the vicinity of 111-114 South Longboat Drive and another sewer collapse on October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024 in the vicinity of 111-109 South Longboat Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has been advised by its Consulting Engineer Remington and Vernick in a letter dated November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024, that there was a sewer collapse on October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024 in the vicinity of 111-114 South Longboat Drive and another one on October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024 in the vicinity of 111-109 South Longboat Drive. The Authority finds that an emergency must be declared in order to authorize the immediate expenditure of funds to perform the necessary repairs for both locations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority previously awarded a contract to Crest Construction Group, LLC. for emergency water and sewer repair services after public advertisement and the receipt of formal bids in accordance with the provisions of the "Local Public Contracts Law", N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** this 12<sup>th</sup> day of November 2024, by the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1 The Authority accepts the recommendation of its Consulting Engineer and declares an emergency in the vicinity of 111-114 South Longboat Drive and another one in the vicinity of 111-109 South Longboat Drive to avoid the potential adverse effects to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents.
- 2 The Authority authorizes its Executive Director to undertake the necessary work with Crest Construction Group, LLC.
- 3 The Authority authorizes and directs its Chairman, Secretary, and/or Executive Director to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.

Dear Mr. Sutton:

On October 28, 2024 a collapse of the existing sanitary sewer main in the vicinity of 111-114 South Longboat Drive occurred necessitating the emergency repair.

Additionally, on October 31, 2024 a collapse of the existing sanitary sewer main in the vicinity of 109-111 South Longboat Drive occurred also necessitating an emergency repair.

Due to the ongoing demand on the Authority's system, it is our recommendation that both of these failures be declared an emergency for immediate repair.

Under the publicly bid annual contract for Emergency Repairs, awarded to Crest Construction for this year, there are unit prices for all labor and materials, which will be used. This emergency declaration was due to the potential adverse effects to the health, safety, and welfare of the Township residents.

WHEREAS, the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as "Authority") has been advised by its Consulting Engineer, Remington & Vernick Engineers, of repairs required for Well #8 and Well #9; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has been advised by its Consulting Engineer by letter dated October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024, that the pump motor for Well #8 failed. In addition, the pump motor for Well #9 requires repairs. The Authority finds that an emergency must be declared in order to authorize the immediate expenditure of funds to perform pump repairs and possible replacement for Well #8 and pump repairs for Well #9; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority has used AC Schultes for emergency repair services in the past and is fully qualifies to perform the required work.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** this 12<sup>th</sup> day of November 2024, by the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1 The Authority accepts the recommendation of its Consulting Engineer and declares an emergency regarding the pump repair and possible replacement for Well #8 and the pump repair of Well #9 to avoid the potential adverse effects to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents.
- 2 The Authority authorizes its Executive Director to undertake the necessary work with AC Schultes.
- 3 The Authority authorizes and directs its Chairman, Secretary, and/or Executive Director to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.

On October 29, 2024, unforeseen conditions required the immediate repair of Wells No. 8 and No. 9. In order to repair well No. 9, the motor shall be repaired at a cost not to exceed \$19,000.00. The work shall be completed by A.C. Schultes, Inc., the Authority's preferred emergency Well contractor.

Additionally, in order to repair Well No.8 the well pump shall be repaired and in the worst case, replaced at a cost not to exceed \$60,000.00. The work shall also be completed by A.C. Schultes, Inc., the Authority's preferred emergency Well contractor.

This emergency declaration was necessitated by the water demand of the Township and the requirement for these wells to remain in service as well as to mitigate potential adverse effects to the health, safety, and welfare of the Township residents.

WHEREAS, the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the ("Authority") has received a request from P & A Construction Company, Inc. for a One Hundred Sixty-One (161) day extension to complete Mystic Islands Phase II water and Sewer Improvements.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** on this 12<sup>th</sup> day of November 2024 by the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

The Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority believes that one hundred sixty-one days is too long and not acceptable to facilitate the Township's contract for drainage and roadway improvement work required within the project limits.

The Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority hereby grants P&A Construction Company, Inc. an Eighty-Two (82) day extension, until February 28, 2025 to complete the Phase II water and sewer improvements. This is provided that the P&A Construction submit an updated construction schedule and sequence with specific timelines for the completion of the project prior to the November 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024 meeting.

1. The Authority authorizes and directs the Chairman, Secretary, and/or Executive Director to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this Resolution.

Our office is in receipt of an email from P&A Construction, Inc., dated November 1, 2024, requesting a 161-day Contract Extension for the above-referenced project. The Contract under the originally executed terms is set to expire on December 8, 2024. According to the Contractor, due to material delays, the original contract period cannot be met. Therefore, Remington & Vernick Engineers, on behalf of the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority, is recommending that the Authority grant an extension of the Contract of 82-days whereas the contract shall expire on February 28, 2025. It shall be the responsibility of P&A Construction to submit an updated construction schedule and sequence with specific timelines for the completion of the below outlined tasks in order to complete the contract by February 28, 2025. As you are aware at the time of award, a stringent timeline was communicated to P&A Construction in order to facilitate the Township's contract for drainage and roadway improvement work required within the project limits.

- Install water services on West Shrewsbury Drive
- Install short side water services on East and West Raritan Drive
- Install long side services and sewer laterals on East and West Susquehanna Drive
- Install long side services and sewer laterals on East and West Raritan Drive
- Install sewer main, laterals, and water services on East Shrewsberry Drive.
- Install sewer main on East and West Susquehanna Drive
- Install sewer main on East and West Raritan Drive
- Install remaining long side services and sewer laterals on East and West Shrewsberry Drive.

Failure to submit an updated construction schedule outlining the following prior to the Authority's November 12, 2024 meeting will result in no Contract Extension being granted by the Authority.
