NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 11th day of January 2023 by the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:



Mathis Construction Co. was called to the site and performed the repair.

Under the publicly bid annual contract for Emergency Repairs, awarded to Mathis Construction Co. for this year, there are unit prices for all labor and materials, which will be used. This emergency declaration was due to the potential adverse effects to the health, safety, and welfare of the Township residents. Any considerations necessary to temporarily restore travel lanes to residents is essential.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 9th day of May 2023, by the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:
