**RESOLUTION OF THE LITTLE EGG HARBOR MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY,  
COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR  
EMERGENCY REPAIRS OF WATER AND SANITARY SEWER MAINS AND SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") has solicited bids for the Emergency Repairs of Water and Sanitary Sewer Mains and Services (the "project"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority has solicited bids in conformance with the provisions of the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, two (2) bids have been submitted to the Authority in conformance with the specifications, as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the bid documentation submitted by the apparent lowest responsible bidder, Crest Construction Group, LLC, has been reviewed by the Authority's solicitor and found to be acceptable as to form and content; and


**WHEREAS**, sufficient funds have been provided for in the Authority's budget:

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June 2026, by the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority, as follows:

1. The Authority accepts the recommendation of its Solicitor and awards the contract for the project to the apparent lowest responsible bidder, Crest Construction Group, LLC, for and in consideration of \$62,404.52, based upon the recommendation of Debra Rumpf, Esquire.
2. The Authority authorizes and directs the Chairman, Secretary and/or Executive Director to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement to the intent of this Resolution.
