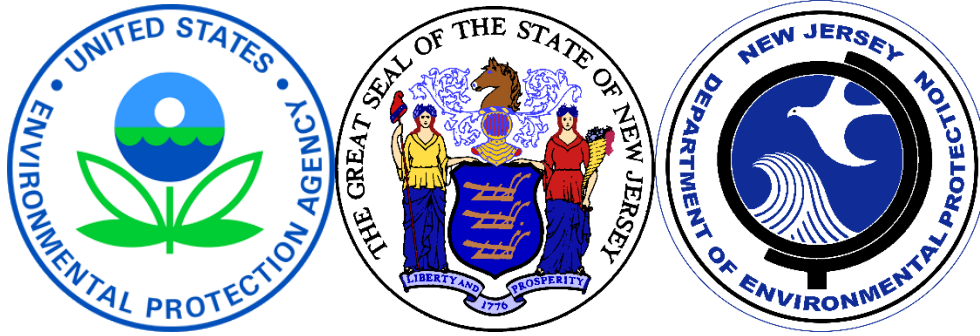




Construction of upgrades and improvements to Mystic Islands Phase III water and sewer replacement within the area of West Playhouse Drive in the amount of \$11,032,000.00 were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits by replacing infrastructure, eliminate groundwater infiltration, and reduce the potential for pollution for residents and businesses in the Little Egg Harbor MUA service area.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
