RESOLUTION OF THE LITTLE EGG HARBOR MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TEMINATING SHARED SERVICES FOR MANPOWER AND EQUIPMENT TO THE BOROUGH OF TUCKERTON

WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is shifting current and future operational needs pertaining to the use of Authority manpower and equipment. In addition, there is an unsustainably high demand on our labor force and an overextension of Authority equipment for outside use. As a result, this has placed the Authority in a precarious position regarding our ability to properly maintain and service our own existing service area and ;

WHEREAS, the Authority has consistently and proudly provided shared services of both manpower, and equipment to the Borough of Tuckerton water and sewer department at no cost and;

WHEREAS, upon evaluation it has been determined that the Authority can no longer provide these services to the Borough of Tuckerton water and sewer department, or to any other outside entity and;

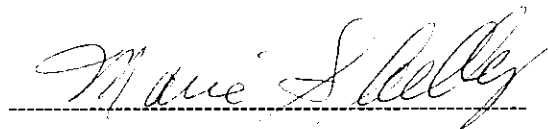
WHEREAS, this will not affect the current interconnection agreement in effect to provide emergency water to the residents of Tuckerton Borough at the Authority cost per 1,000 gallons of water, or during maintenance and repairs of the Borough water tower, and as required by the New Jersey Department of Environmental protection. It is solely to discontinue to provide manpower and equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 7th day of July 2026, by the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1 - The Authority accepts the recommendation of its Executive Director and Superintendent to avoid the potential adverse effects to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents.
- 2 - The Authority authorizes and directs its Chairman, Secretary, and/or Executive Director to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.
