

RESOLUTION #2026-38

RESOLUTION OF THE LITTLE EGG HARBOR MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO PERFORM ASPHALT RESTORATION IN THE VICINITY OF 143 AND 145 NORTH SPINNAKER DRIVE AS THE RESULT OF A HYDRAULIC LINE BREAK ON AUTHORITY EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the Authority has been advised by its Consulting Engineer Remington and Vernick in a letter dated July 1st, 2026, that asphalt restoration is required at the vicinity of 143 and 145 North Spinnaker Drive as the result of a hydraulic line break on Authority equipment. The Authority finds that an emergency must be declared in order to authorize the immediate expenditure of funds to perform the necessary replacement; and

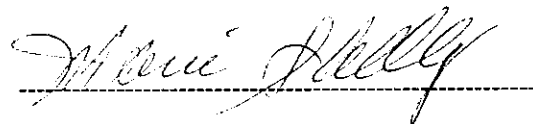
WHEREAS, the Authority previously awarded a contract to Crest Construction Group, LLC. for emergency water and sewer repair services after public advertisement and the receipt of formal bids in accordance with the provisions of the "Local Public Contracts Law", N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 7th day of July 2026, by the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1 - The Authority accepts the recommendation of its Consulting Engineer and declares an emergency in the vicinity of 143 and 145 North Spinnaker Drive to avoid the potential adverse effects to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents.
- 2 - The Authority authorizes its Executive Director to undertake the necessary work with Crest Construction Group, LLC.
- 3 - The Authority authorizes and directs its Chairman, Secretary, and/or Executive Director to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.

Dear Mr. Sutton:

On June 29, 2026, in the vicinity of 143 and 145 North Spinnaker Drive, the Authority was conducting emergency repairs to its water infrastructure when the failure of a hydraulic line on a piece of equipment resulted in the spill of hydraulic fluid over the roadway in an environmentally sensitive area. Due to the emergent nature of this circumstance, it is the recommendation of this office that the situation be declared an emergency for immediate repair. The Little Egg Harbor MUA contracted Crest Construction to make repairs to the roadway at a cost not to exceed \$20,000.00. This emergency declaration was due to potential adverse effects to health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Little Egg Harbor Township.
