RESOLUTION OF THE LITTLE EGG HARBOR MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF A PERFORMANCE BOND BY JVS INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL CONTRACTORS, INC. IN REGARD TO THE REPLACEMENT OF THE CHLORINE CONTACT TANK AT WELL #13

WHEREAS, the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") has received a request from JVS Industrial and Commercial Contractors, Inc. (the "Contractor") for a release of the performance bond for the replacement of the chlorine contact tank at well #13 (the "project"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority has authorized and directed its Consulting Engineer, Remington & Vernick Engineers, to review the work which has been performed to provide a recommendation as to whether the performance bond should be released; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has received a letter of recommendation from its Consulting Engineer for the Project, Alan B. Dittenhofer, P.E., P.P., C.M.E., which letter is dated August 10, 2026, which letter indicates that the request for the release of the performance bond should be granted, and a maintenance guarantee is required in the amount of \$192,185.00; and

WHEREAS, the approval of the request for the release of the performance guarantee for the project is in accordance with the Authority's Rules and Regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this 11th day of August 2026, by the Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority, as follows:

1. The Authority accepts the recommendations of its Consulting Engineer for the project and approves the request for the release of the performance bond for the replacement of the chlorine contact tank for well #13 in accordance with the requirements set forth in the August 10, 2026 letter from its Consulting Engineer.
2. The Authority authorizes and directs the Chairman, Secretary and/or Executive Director to execute all necessary documents to implement to the intent of this Resolution.
